There is one rule for a happy survival in room 1301. Be courteous. This implies courtesy to your teacher and to other students.

Courtesy demands that you:

- 1) Be on time for class. There will be a daily warm up exercise at the start of each class. You must be in your seat at the bell to get credit. (5 pts)
- 2) Have your own notebook, pencil, and textbook, so that you will not be imposing on others.
- 3) **No one talks when the teacher is talking.**
- 4) All your class work and homework should be done on time and according to directions. All work will be done in pencil. (nothing else will be excepted, NO PENS!!)
- 5) All students will be required to keep a **notebook** of all assignments and notes. Assignments will be checked daily and notebooks will be graded at the end of each term.
- 6) Ask questions politely and be attentive to the explanations given for both your questions and those of other students.
- 7) Try to understand what is being taught. When you do not understand, question the teacher. (not your neighbor)
- 8) Aim to do well in all you do. Quizzes or tests will be given once a week.
- 9) The weekly quizzes will help you see how you are progressing.

Quizzes are 20 points each.

Notebooks are 100 points for the end of a term and 20 points for the mid-term.

Daily warm up is 5 points per day. Tests are 100 points each.

FINAL EXAM 150 points (end of second term only)

Grading scale is in your student handbook.

10) Make-up work is your responsibility. YOU are to get the assignment when you return to class, complete it and show it to me. You have as many days as you were absent to complete the work. If you were gone on a Friday expect to take a quiz/test on Monday. Quiz/tests will need to be made up before or after school. Make arrangements with the teacher. Daily warmups need to be made up and turned in to the teacher when you are absent also.

Makeup work is the students responsibility. If you are absent, you need to do the following:

-makeup warmup,- get notes and copy them, -get assignment and complete it.

Tardy Policy: 1st tardy-freebie 2nd and any tardies after that-lose warmup points (5)

Parental contact after 4 tardies to make a plan to fix the problem.
