Wednesday Intervention Night

The **WIN** program is the chance to provide every possible opportunity to aid students through their learning journey. Some students need more support, practice, motivation, or contact time than others and **WIN** will provide an avenue to address all those individual needs.

1. **When:** Wednesdays after school for one hour (3:30-4:30) starting October 3, 2007 and concluding on May 7, 2008.
2. **Who:** Targeting students in grades 3-5 who exhibit:
 - a. Chronic issues with incomplete work
 - b. Skill deficiencies that could be addressed with additional re-teaching, guided practice, and time
3. **How it works:**
 - A snack will be provided partnering with Kids Klub.
 - Teachers will refer students needing assistance and staff/tutor on a rotation basis.
 - Classroom teachers will provide work in needed skill areas.
 - Student attendance will be mandatory for identified students
 - Students will be assigned on a one to three week rotation basis, as needed
 - Principals/counselors will be available to support staff with any ongoing student behaviors or other issues
4. *Other things you should know about the WIN Program:*
 - This is NOT a behavioral consequence...it is a time for skill building, catching up on, tutoring individuals or small groups, providing interventions, etc.
 - Parent contacts will be made prior to the assigned Wednesday School so families can appropriate accommodations for transportation, siblings, etc.
 - Students not picked up at WIN dismissal time will be taken to Kids Klub. Parents will be responsible for any fees accumulated at Kids Klub.
